1. Fourteen (14) days for general cleanup, new roofs and similar activities on Private Property.
2. Fourteen (14) days for general cleanup, new roofs and similar activities on Public Street or Alley.
3. Thirty (30) days for new construction on Public Street or Alley*.
4. Forty-five (45) days for remodeling, additions and similar activities on Private Property.
5. Eight (8) months for new construction on Private Property
6. As determined by the Building Inspector – Code Administrator – Public Works Director for projects other than the above.

6-7-1 Temporary Dumpsters on Private Property may be placed only by Permit issued by The City Building Inspector/Code Administrator. **There is no fee for the initial 90 day duration dumpster permit.** After the initial 90 day permit expires, a request for a renewal permit for 30 days upon payment of \$50.00. Failure to obtain a permit or renew an expired permit shall result in a fine of \$25.00 per day that dumpster is located on property in the City.

6-7-2 Temporary Dumpsters on a Public Streets or alley may be placed only with permission of the Public Works Director and with a permit issued by The City. Barricades must be placed at both ends of the dumpster if located on a public right of way or alley. No street, alley or fire hydrant may be blocked to vehicular traffic by the dumpster. The fee and fine schedule is the same as a dumpster located on private property
